### *"The End of the Commandment"*

#### **1 Timothy 1:5**

*"Now the end of the commandment is charity out of a pure heart, and of a good conscience, and of faith unfeigned:"*

The goal of all of God's true people is to reach the fullness of God in Christ Jesus. As Apostle Paul was ministering to his son in the faith Timothy, by the holy Ghost, he was saying that Timothy should **"set out for a definite goal, that he should aim at charity"**, and that, out of a pure heart and a good conscience, and that will come from faith unfeigned, (a direct revealed Word from God in his spirit that will reveal Christ in him.)

Everything we need to serve God in his fullness (Charity) comes from God himself. Man is not the origin of Charity, but the recipient through communion with God. Communion with the Spirit and with the Word, with the Father and with the Son is Life. (1 John 1). God is calling his Body into a supping relationship (Rev. 3:20) with him, that we might "know" the love of Christ. **"And to know the love of Christ, which passeth knowledge, that ye might be filled with all the fullness of God."** Ephesians 3:19. In our supping relationship with the Lord, we "know" him. Or receive of him an impregnated word that will cause us to grow as Christ grows and forms himself in us. This knowing is a perception of our spirit, literally a understanding of God's true Love. A Word of the fullness of God, is a word that is meat to be given in due season, not milk. In other words it is not the beginning principles, but mature word. In Revelation 3:20, Jesus speaks of this supping relationship. The "Sup" in the original Greek means the evening meal, or the last meal of the DAY! Jesus is now inviting his people to eat the evening meal, the meal that will supply all the needed sustenance for the body. The last meal is the best meal of the day. The meal or communion of bread and wine, the eating of His flesh and the drinking of his Blood, that will bring the Life of God into us. (John 6) And we will know that we have passed from death unto life because we LOVE the brethren. **"Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that heareth my word, and believeth on him that sent me, hath everlasting life, and shall not come into condemnation; but is passed from death unto life. (John 5:24) We know that we have passed from death unto life, because we love the brethren. He that loveth not his brother abideth in death. (1 John 3:14) And the Love of God is perceived (understood) by one laying down his life for the brethren. Laying down our will and our wants,**

*being dead to trespasses and sins, being dead to selfishness, and things; that when required, we sacrifice our wants for others needs. "Hereby perceive we the love of God, because he laid down his life for us: and we ought to lay down our lives for the brethren." 1 John 3:16 No man takes our life, but we lay it down willingly. John 10:18. This is my commandment, That ye love one another, as I have loved you. John 15:12. Inasmuch as you have done it to the least of these my brethren you have done it unto me. Matthew 25:31-40.*

*We as God's elect must enter into this Supping relationship with our Lord so that we can receive this charity, which is the maturity of CHRIST IN US!*
